## Remembrance Day – Old Peterite Memorial Competition.

Every year on 11 November we hold an Armistice Day (Remembrance Day) Service, and a silence at 11am to remember those who have fought and died in the line of duty. Across the country on the closest Sunday, Remembrance Sunday Services and Parades take place up and down the country where we remember those who have given their lives in service to our Country.

As a tutor group we would like you to develop a design that will commemorate and remember those Old Peterites who have given their lives so we can display this each year, as a visual reminder for our community.

Your design must take in to account the following points:

- The display will be shown on the Horseshoe, at the front of School – see image below
- It must not be expensive to produce
- Must be able to be manufactured in School
- Weatherproof
- Easy to dismantle and clean
- Easy to store for the remainder of the year (not take up too much space)
- Last for at least 5 years
- Contain the name, rank, unit and date of death of the Old Peterites
- It will need to commemorate around 120 Old Peterites

Each tutor group is asked to submit their annotated idea and design on a sheet of A4 to Ms Staniforth.

Entries must be received from each tutor group by Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November.

Entries will be judged by a panel of representatives from across the School.

In conjunction with the Design and Technology Department, there will be the opportunity to help produce the winning design, ready for display in November 2021.



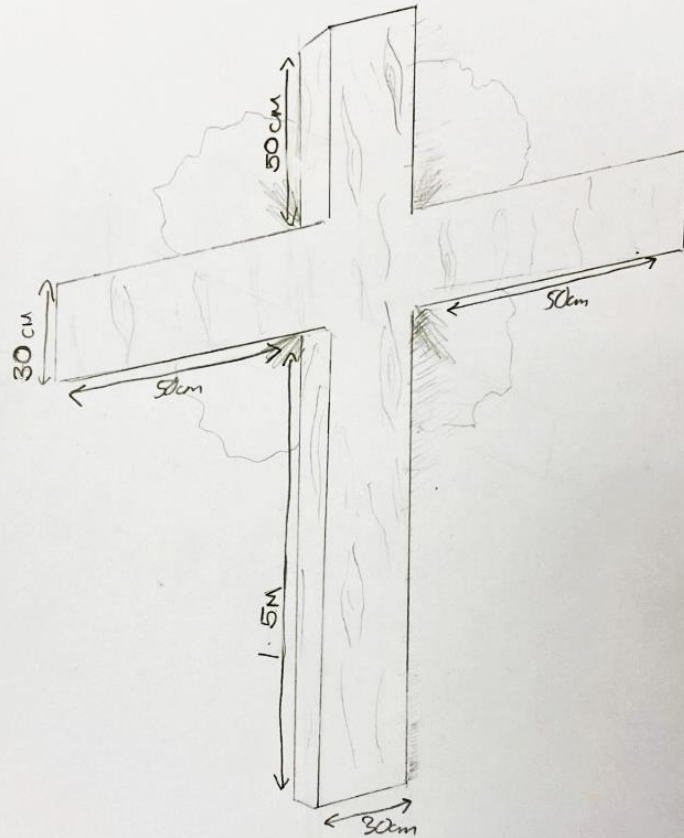

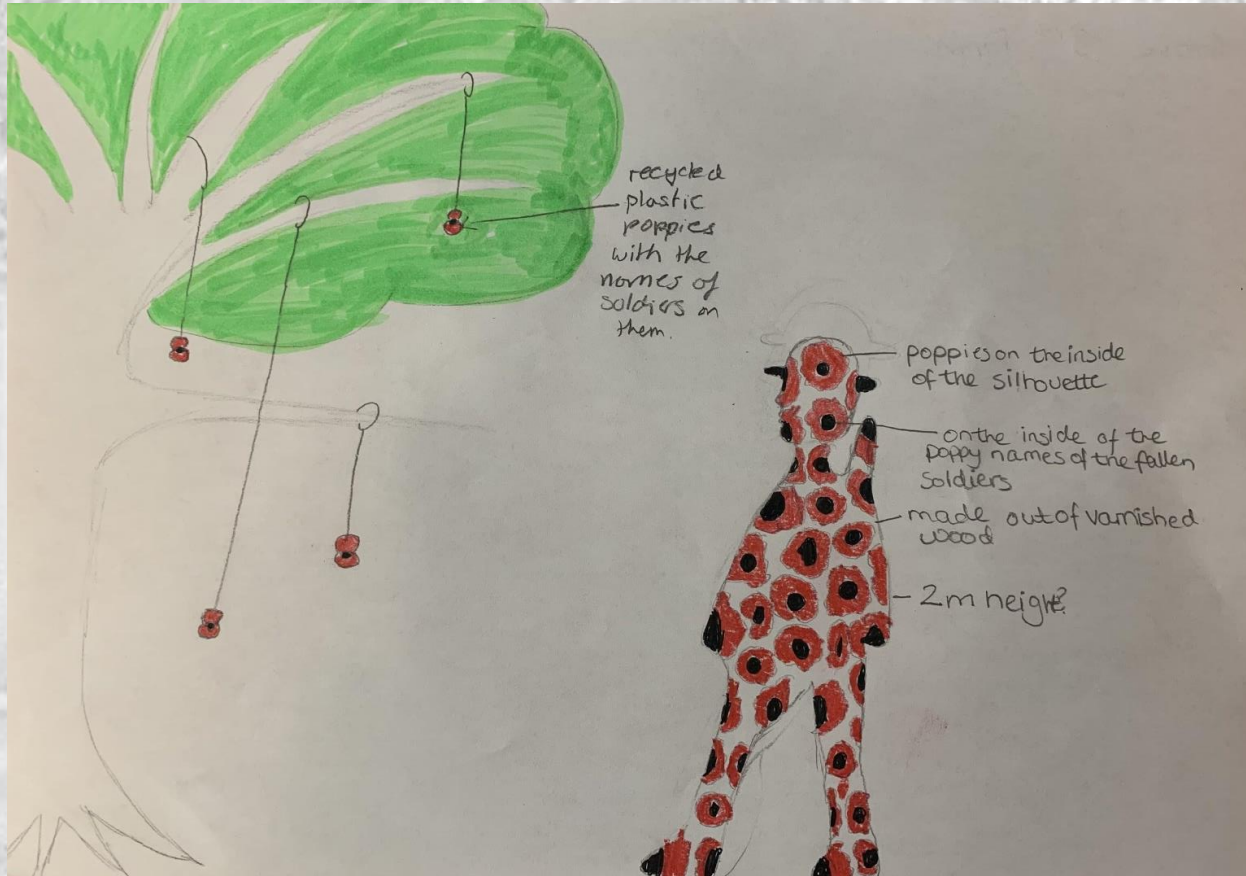


# 3rd Form Hope



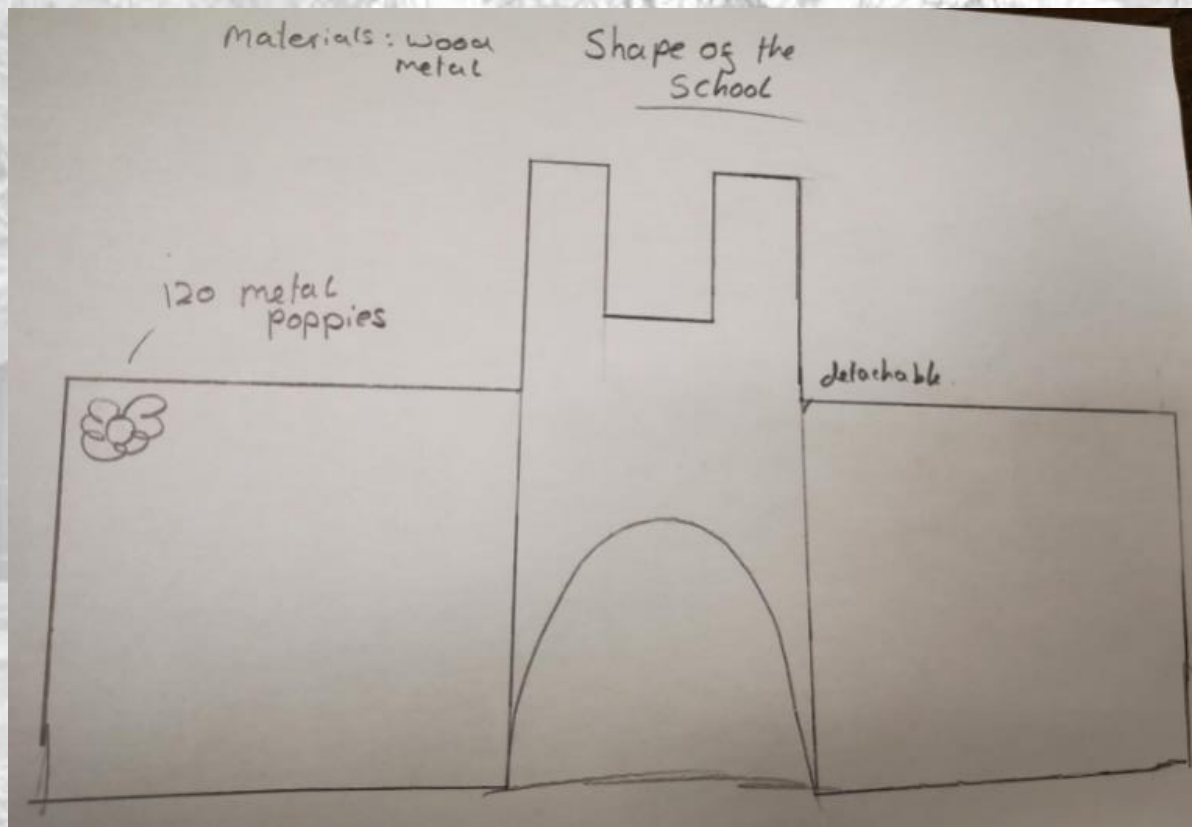
The poppy behind the cross is roughly 90cm x 90cm. The cross is made of wood, which is then varnished. Carve the names into the wood. To store the poppy can be disattached. The front and side pieces can be removed using nuts and bolts. The poppy can be made of timber and then stained red.

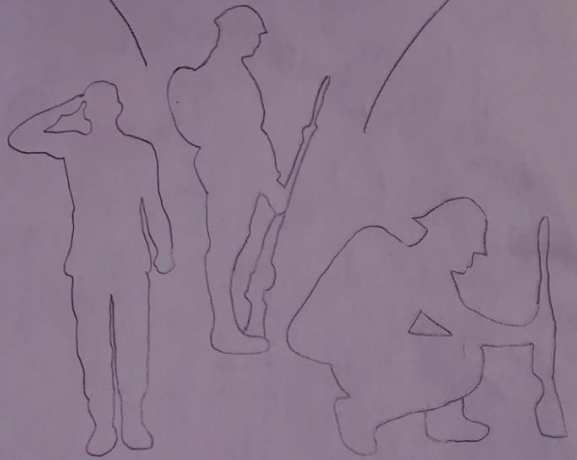


# Upper 6th - Dronfield

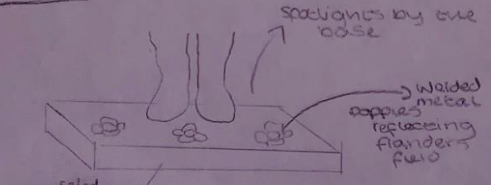
Our design idea is to make twelve metal silhouettes of soldiers which are placed around campus in the run up to Remembrance Day and then brought together for the service.

solid, metal base with 10 names + ranks engraved around the edge

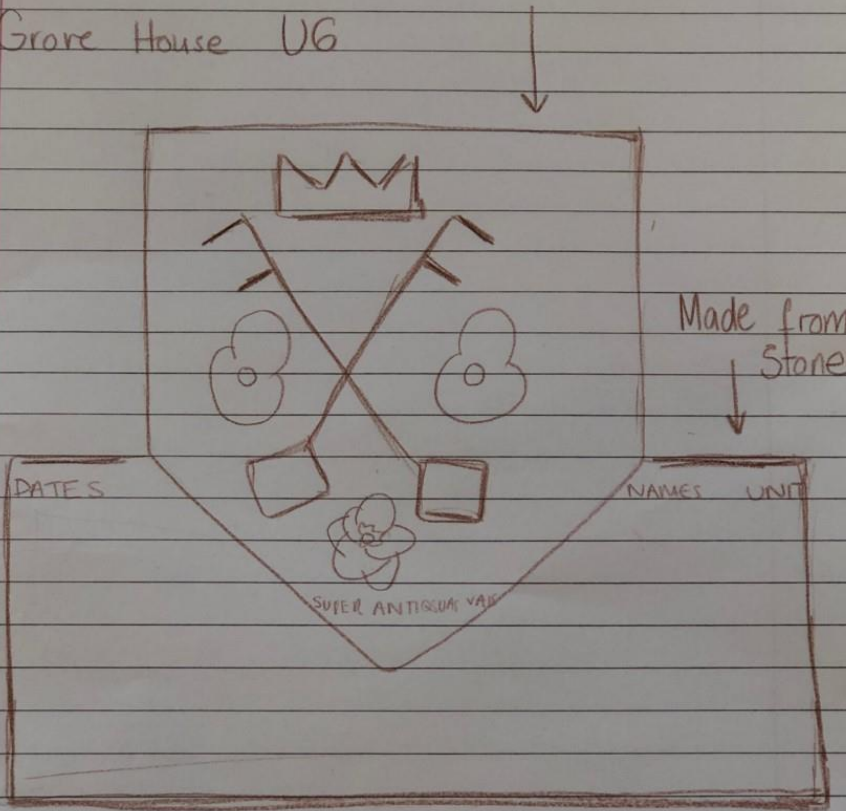

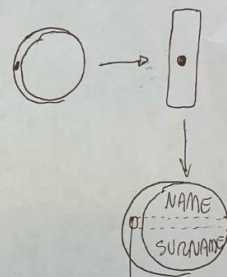
